I hope this finds you well as you are preparing for the next school year. As you know, at the Cathedral we have been blessed with the generosity of a number of benefactors who have enabled us to award scholarships to Cathedral families who send their children to Sacred Heart Jr/Sr High.

Sadly, over the past few years, we have been experiencing increasing difficulties with families who expect to receive scholarship awards while failing to meet even the most minimum of requirements. Some of these include:

- Failure to sign the application
- Failure to get a letter of recommendation from a teacher
- Failure to turn in paperwork by the stated deadline
- Failure to completely fill out the application

This is free money that is being awarded, and not much is being required to receive it. Filling out the application and getting the associated paperwork ready to go is good practice for students who may one day be applying for scholarships hoping to attend college.

Our team here at the Cathedral strives to be fair in awarding the scholarships. When applicants fail to get applications completed on time, or turn in applications that are incomplete, it makes their job more difficult and is unfair to the applicants who have turned in a complete application.

For this reason, for the 24-25 school year we will be adopting the following policy:

- •The deadline is the deadline. If you miss the deadline, you will not be considered for a scholarship this year.
- •Only complete applications will be accepted and evaluated. You will be responsible for turning in a complete application. If the team receives an incomplete application, you will <u>NOT</u> be notified to provide missing information/documentation. Applications that are incomplete will be thrown in the trash and the applicant will not be considered for a scholarship this year.

Again, we are pleased to be able to offer these scholarships, but your cooperation is necessary for the process of awarding them to go smoothly and fairly.
